MAKING YOUR VOLUNTEER HOURS COUNT

One way schools are recognized is by parent participation and how many volunteer hours they accumulate. Volunteer hours are recorded through a software called RAPTOR. In order for your volunteer hours to count toward your school, you must create a virtual volunteer account. This account allows you to track and log your hours. If you are volunteering during the school hours, this can be done by the front desk; after hours, you can log them yourself.

 - * Assist with ticket sales at events
